CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO AMEND THE 2023 VILLAGE BUDGET TO INCLUDE EXPENSES AND OFFSETTING DONATIONS FOR JULY 4TH FIREWORKS:

President Clark made a motion to amend the 2023 village budget to add \$30,000 into park and rec. and \$24,500 to revenues. Seconded by Trustee Butendorf to approve the amendment to the 2023 Village Budget to include expenses and offsetting donations for July 4th fireworks. Unanimously approved.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO TRANSFER SURPLUS FROM PAST FIREWORKS DONATIONS TO THE 2023 DONATIONS FUND:

President Clark informed the Board there was a \$5,750 fireworks fund surplus from the last five years and asked that that be transferred into the fireworks donations fund. Motion made by Trustee Butendorf to approve the transfer surplus from past fireworks donations to the 2023 donations fund. Seconded by Trustee Perrault. Unanimously approved.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ENABLING DIRECT REVIEW OF AUDIT REPORTS BY THE VILLAGE BOARD:

President Clark updated the Board concerning the ordinance amendment. Motion made by Trustee Renner to the adoption of an ordinance amendment to 1.16(7)(a) enabling direct review of audit reports by the Village Board. Seconded by Trustee Butendorf. Unanimously approved.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO REAPPOINT MARK MICKELSON OF SEH AS VILLAGE ENGINEER:

President Clark updated the Board concerning Village Engineer Mark Mickelson's rates as principal engineer. Motion made by Trustee Wille to reappoint Village Engineer Mark Mickelson of SEH as Village Engineer. Seconded by Trustee Renner. Unanimously approved.

CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF THE WAUKESHA COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN WHICH IS AVAILABLE AT:

President Clark updated the Board on the 678-page mitigation plan. Attorney de la Mora updated the Board that the plan we are accepting is the 2021 plan. In order to get Federal Funds the Village needs to be part of this plan. Motion made by President Clark to approve the adoption of the Waukesha County all Hazards Mitigation plan. Seconded by Trustee Butendorf. Unanimously approved.

DISCUSSION OF OPTIONS TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC SAFETY. NO ACTION TAKEN.

Trustee Butendorf discussed traffic safety in the village. Trustee Butendorf proposed closing the road in front of OSRUI on the lake side starting at Sang Hall on the south end and the end of beach area on the north end. Extensive discussion amongst the Board. No action taken.

REVIEW ALLOWABLE ACTIONS RELATED TO CLEARING HAZARDS FROM AREAS DESIGNATED AS CONSERVANCY:

President Clark updated the Board concerning the removal of Ash trees behind village resident, Mr. Ritter's home located at 468 Lac LaBelle Drive. Village Administrator Stumpf said the Village has allowed residents to clear dead ash trees on a case by case basis. Village Administrator Stumpf said Mr. Ritter can contact him as part of his duties at the Village Forester.

DISCUSSION OF STATUS OF STREAM BANK RESTORATION ON THE GOLF COURSE CREEK:

Update given by Village President. Village Engineer Mark Mickelson has been overseeing the project.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

Village Administrator Stumpf updated the Board concerning discussions with OSRUI. Village Administrator Stumpf informed the Board the snow plow broke down during the cold spike. The February Board of Trustee meeting will be cancelled and the next meeting will be March 15, 2023.
