



- 33 (iv) Music and performance facilities directly related to a permitted use.  
34  
35 (v) Limited animal husbandry for non-commercial educational purposes conducted  
36 within areas approved by the Plan Commission.  
37  
38 (vi) Seasonal gazebos and structures utilized for uses otherwise permitted in the I-1  
39 District that are less than 6'x6' in size, are not more than ten (10) feet in height, and  
40 that are not permanently anchored to the ground or any permanent structure.  
41  
42 (vii) Vegetable and/or flower gardens not more than one-half (1/2) acre in size used for  
43 non-commercial, educational purposes.  
44  
45 (viii) Activities and uses of an organized religion not otherwise expressly permitted by this  
46 section that do not constitute the exercise of religion.  
47  
48 (ix) Installation of fencing of a length and height to be determined by the Plan  
49 Commission along or adjacent to any portion of a boundary of a property intended  
50 and utilized to maintain and promote the health, security and safety of the owner and  
51 any occupants, operators, patrons or licensees visiting such property. Such fence  
52 shall be maintained in good condition at all times, and the allowance of a fence to  
53 deteriorate so that it becomes structurally unsound or an aesthetic detriment to the  
54 neighborhood is grounds for the Plan Commission to revoke the conditional use  
55 permit.

56  
57 **SECTION 2:** If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any  
58 reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall  
59 be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the  
60 validity of the remainder of such ordinance.

62 **SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and  
63 publication.
